Product overview

1. Verify that the device model is correct, all accessories are complete, and charge for 4 hours.
2. Prepare a Nano SIM card compatible with the 4G network, specific to the distributor's advice. (Please turn off the watch before inserting the SIM card)
3. The SIM card for the watch needs to have GPRS, caller ID, and VoLTE (Voice over LTE) functions activated.
4. Please do not insert any objects (such as a SIM card ejector tool) into the hole marked as ①.

Install the Nano SIM card

This watch functions like a smart mini-phone and supports most carriers' 4G Nano SIM cards. If using a new card, please contact the SIM card carrier to activate it. After activation, it may take up to 24 hours for GPRS and data settings to sync and update with the device.

1. To insert the SIM card:
1) Turn off the watch by selecting "Power off" in the settings, then insert the SIM card.
2) Insert the Nano SIM card into the slot next to the watch.



2. Open the watch and swipe down from the top of the screen in the dial interface. If the SIM card is successfully activated and inserted, the top of the screen should display the 4G cellular signal and its strength (as shown in the image).

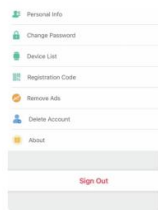


3. If there's a card reading failure (as shown in the image), you can test the SIM card status by inserting it into a phone (make a call or receive one) to see if the card is activated or overdue.



Bind the watch to the APP account:

After parents log in to the device, open the APP, enter the device binding section, select the smart watch device type, and open the registration code in the device information. Then, on the phone, click to scan and bind. Registration code information: in the device information of the watch, enter the registration code page, scan or enter the 15-digit registration code displayed on the watch.



1. Base station, GPS, WIFI positioning: View real-time location on the APP map.
2. Footprints: View historical tracks.
3. Safe zones: set up to three safety perimeters centred on the child, then input a circle with a radius of 200-500 metres as the child's safety zone. When the child leaves the designated area, the watch will send an alert notification.
4. Dialing: the watch can make independent calls, with this function enabled or disabled via the app.
5. Contacts: the watch can store phone numbers in its address book and conduct calls with paired devices.
6. Settings: volume adjustment, brightness control, power off, device information (version number, IMEI), language selection.
7. Video calls: select individual or group video calls by tapping.
8. Call history: view the history of calls.
9. Photo: click to take photo.
10. Binding information: including the registration code of the watch and APP download address.

Operation method

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Download method:

- 1) Method 1: Click to scan the QR code of the watch information page, scan QR code to download APP.
- 2) Method 2: Scan the QR code below to download and install Selftracker2 or Selftracker.
- 3) Parents can use the app to view their children's location information, map the location of the watch, set up electronic fences, track footprints, utilize intelligent motion tracking, and stay informed about exercise routines at any time.



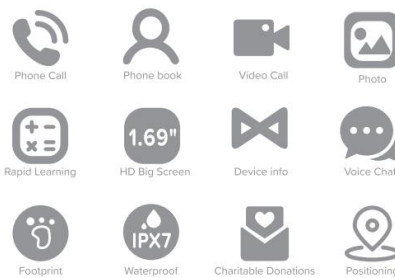
Register and log in:

Follow the instructions in the APP to register an account correctly and log in. Make sure to choose the correct location, language, and region.



How to use

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1. Alarm: multiple alarms can be set.
2. Pedometer: must be enabled within the application.
3. Gallery: view photographs captured by the watch. Images can be shared or deleted.
4. Time: adjust settings as required via the mobile application.
5. SOS: configure emergency contact numbers.
6. Do not disturb periods: set three time slots during which the watch will block all calls and notifications (valid monday to friday).
7. SMS alert settings: control whether SMS notifications are enabled for relevant alerts (standard SMS charges apply).
8. Family members: displays all family member accounts linked to the watch.
9. Working mode: three distinct location-tracking frequencies can be configured; manual location retrieval via Sleep Mode is recommended.
10. Remote power off: once the watch is powered on and functioning normally, it can be remotely powered off via the app.
